Grows On-Net Footprint 196%, Outperforms Network Reliability Goals and Exceeds CSR Targets

WireIE's expertise in providing fast and reliable networks is unmatched. Using a hybrid approach based on fiber and digital radio, WireIE delivers high-availability networks to underserved markets across Canada with a minimum 99.9% service availability.

WireIE prides itself on its "anytime, anywhere networks" mentality. Most global carriers, including WireIE's customers and partners, define minimum Carrier Ethernet network performance measurements via service level agreements (SLAs). WireIE met and even exceeded many of these key SLA performance metrics in 2014, including:

- 99.97% network availability (corporate target: 99.9%)
- 2.41 hours Mean Time to Repair (MTTR) (corporate target: ≤8 hours)
- 4.4 millisecond one-way latency (corporate target: ≤35ms)
- 0.11% packet loss (corporate target: ≤0.5%)

In addition to excellent 2014 service performance, WireIE also celebrates strong accomplishments for Corporate Social Responsibility in 2014. The company recently won Capacity Magazine's Global Carrier Award for Corporate Social Responsibility. In addition, the company successfully organized its third annual Hope Classic Golf Tournament this summer and supported the 10th Annual Gala Dinner and Auction for Hope Air, a charity WireIE has supported for years.
