The following examples illustrate a range of work that WirelE has performed in order to provide connectivity to underserved communities across Canada:

Scenario 2: Scenario 1: Partnership: Mt. Wallensteen, BC

- Major NAV Canada radar station; 20km west of Salmon Arm, BC, 2000m altitude change
- Replaced legacy T1 service with 10Mbps Ethernet service
- Access through challenging terrain
- · Partnered with Allstream and Shaw
- Time to deploy: 6 months
- Cost to deploy (wholesale): \$172k

Remote Underserved Market: Swan River, MB

- · Underserved deployment
- · Extended Ethernet connectivity 15km from nearest POP in **Minetonas**
- Swan River Population: 4,000
- Delivering 10Mbps to end Customer (GENS/HRDC)
- Time to deploy: 6 months
- Cost to deploy (wholesale): \$200k

Connecting Canada's underserved markets nationally for over 10 years

Scenario 3: Indigenous: Wikwemikong, ON

- 300Mbps managed Ethernet service to community of Wikwemikong
- Enable triple play offering (Internet, IPTV, Phone) to First Nations community (200 homes)
- · Previously served by very poor, expensive DSL and cable TV services
- Time to deploy: 1.5 months
- Cost to deploy (wholesale): Total cost for backhaul + triple play solution \$270k
